

# AMERICAN LEGION POST 275 STANDING ORDERS 2024

- American Legion Post 275 is a member only Veterans Service Organization.
- Current members of any American Legion, VFW, AMVETS, DAV or Canadian Legion Posts are allowed in the social quarters without having to sign in as guests.
- The social quarters are open to the Suncoast Brotherhood members during Suncoast Brotherhood meetings and events.
- The social quarters are open to the public for Bingo, Sunday breakfast & special events only.
- Membership Cards-Each bartender is required to check membership cards. Be prepared to show your current membership card when ordering your first drink and whenever requested by a bartender.
- American Legion Post 275 Officers may ask to see membership cards at any time.
- Current American Legion Post 275 members may sponsor 2 guest for visit to the social quarters.
- Current members of a visiting American Legion, VFW, AMVETS, DAV, or Canadian Legion Post may sponsor 1 guest while visiting Post 275's social quarters.
  - Each guest must be signed in.
  - Guests may not purchase alcohol. The guest sponsor must purchase alcoholic beverages for their guest.
  - Guests must depart the post property with their sponsor.
- Profanity is prohibited.
- Discrimination, Physical & Verbal abuse of anyone will not be tolerated.
  - Bartenders oversee the social quarters.
  - Bartenders will report all incidents to the Lounge Committee for action.
- No form of Marijuana (including medical) may be smoked on the post property.
- No personal coolers are permitted.
- Smoking is permitted on the deck only.
  - Dispose of smoking material in its proper receptacle.
- No one under 18 may sit at the bar.
- No one under 18 is permitted in the social quarters after 8PM.
- No one under 18 may participate in raffles.
- Anyone 18 or older & approved for the social quarters may play the Sweeps machines & Pull tabs.
- Bartenders & Officers with access to the offices are not allowed to play the pull tab machines.
- Alcoholic beverages are only to be consumed in the social club except for special permitted events.
  - The deck is considered part of the social club.
- Food must be consumed in the social club unless packaged To Go.
- Police your tables upon leaving. Dispose of your trash & return glassware to the bar.
- Pets are not permitted inside the social quarters. Pets are welcome on the deck.
- Service Dogs are permitted in the social quarters. Only two questions may be asked.
  - Is the service dog required because of a disability?
  - What work or task has the dog been trained to perform?
